 Middle grade cover is provided by anaesthetic trainees on a 1:8 rota.
 Junior cover is provided by 6 Foundation Yr 2 doctors on a 24 hr 1:6 full shift rota.
 A variety of A/E, junior anaesthetic and respiratory trainees are also attached to the unit for training.
