3.7 How is the unit staffed

There are Consultant Intensivist ward rounds 7 days a week.
We run a "consultant of the week" model.
The unit also has an airway trained resident doctor 24/7.

Part 4 Training

4.1 Details of training opportunities on the unit

We are a young, enthusiastic department committed to providing high quality clinical and educational supervision to our trainees.

All trainees will undergo a formal unit induction and be assigned an educational supervisor who in addition to the Faculty Tutor will establish an educational contract, provide guidance via WBPA's and facilitate achievement of all competencies at the relevant level.

In addition to obtaining experience in all aspects of general adult critical care trainee's will be encouraged to develop an area of specific interest eg bronchoscopy, echocardiography, lung ultrasound or simulation .

Senior trainees (Stage 2/3) will also be encouraged to undertake management and leadership training (provided in-house) whilst at HDFT and given the opportunity to take a lead role in service development projects.

4.2 Details of departmental teaching days

- Weekly Grand Round.
- Monthly ICM "Virtual" Journal Club.
- Weekly half day teaching sessions. (Protected teaching. Covers topics across both FICM and RCOA curriculums).

4.3 Details of clinical governance meetings and / or M & M

- Monthly clinical governance / M&M meeting shared with anaesthesia.

4.4 Number of trainees on each tier of the rota

The unit is staffed with a FY1, a resident anaesthetic / ICM specialist trainee and a consultant intensivist.

Support is available out of hours from the middle grade anaesthetist (resident) or consultant on call (non-resident).
