

## EXAMINATION CANDIDATE PHOTOGRAPHIC PROOF OF IDENTITY AT ALL FFICM EXAMINATIONS

All candidates for examinations of the Fellowship of the Faculty of Intensive Care Medicine are required to have with them, at the time of taking their examinations, photographic identity. This must be in the form of a PASSPORT or PHOTO DRIVING LICENCE. The candidate must be able to produce this when requested by the Faculty Officer or security staff working on behalf of the Faculty. Please note that Hospital ID is not acceptable.

Where the name on the photographic identity being used is not identical to that given on the candidate's application form, due to marriage etc, then the original marriage certificate or solicitor's letter, as appropriate, must also be produced.

The Faculty should be informed in advance of attendance where this is the case (020 7092 1521).

FAILURE TO PRODUCE AN ACCEPTABLE FORM OF PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTITY WILL RESULT IN THE CANDIDATE NOT BEING ALLOWED TO CONTINUE WITH THE EXAMINATION.
