3.4 Overview of case mix within the unit

We have a busy 10 bedded unit admitting around 600 patients a year, which are used flexibly between level 3 and level 2 care. We are currently occupying an operating theatre with two additional beds. There are plans to move to a larger unit in the coming years.

The case mix is 40% surgical and 60% medical. Surgical specialities include major GI, urology, orthopaedics and gynaecology.

3.7 How is the unit staffed?

Consultant Staffing:-

Dedicated ITU consultant cover 24/7

ITU consultant outreach sessions 0800-1300 Monday - Friday

A hot week consultant covers 0800-1900 Monday to Thursday and 0800-1400 Friday

On call evening consultants are on site until 10pm on weekdays

Weekend consultant overs from 1300 Friday to 0800 Monday

Junior Medical Staffing:-

Our unit is staffed by a mixture of SAS doctors, anaesthetic trainees (CT1, ST5), medical trainees, FY2 doctors and clinical fellows.

There is an ITU registrar covering the unit 24 hours a day on a 1 in 8 rota

Junior (non-airway trained rota) is also 1 in 8

Additional 'normal day' trainees each day (between 1 and 4)

There are three additional anaesthetic on call tiers within the hospital, one of which is based on ITU
