Our general Critical Care Unit has capacity for six level 3 patients and six level 2 patients. Admissions are from a wide range of medical specialties including Acute Medicine, Cardiology, Respiratory Medicine, Gastroenterology, Rheumatology, Haematology and Care of the Elderly. The surgical specialties represented are General Surgical, tertiary Gynaecological-oncology, Orthopaedics and Trauma. A significant proportion are direct from the Emergency Department.

3.7 How is the unit staffed?

During the day the Unit is staffed with two consultants and two doctors in training posts. The Level 3 residents come from different backgrounds including Anaesthetic, ACCS, Respiratory Medicine and Internal Medicine training programmes. The Level 2 resident is usually a Foundation Year 2 doctor.

Nurse staffing comprises ten qualified staff per shift along with healthcare assistants, ward clerks and student nurses.

Critical care receives daily clinical input from microbiology, pharmacy, dietetics, physiotherapy and there is a dedicated rehabilitation team.

'Out of hours' there is a consultant on call along with two resident doctors daytime (08:00 to 20:00) and one or two resident doctors overnight (20:00 to 08:00).

Part 4

Training

4.1 Details of training opportunities on the unit

The unit provides clinical training in the regional programmes for Intensive Care Medicine (all stages), anaesthesia (all stages), ACCS, IMT and the Foundation Programme.

In addition there is a training programme for higher trainees in Respiratory Medicine through a four month rotation in ICM.

Specific training opportunities include experience of perioperative medicine, FICE accreditation, GCP training and recruitment into research.

- 2. Fridays 12:45 to 13:15: Case based ICM and anaesthesia teaching.
- 3. Monthly combined ICM and Anaesthesia half day teaching.
