#### 4.1 Details of training opportunities on the unit

Placements provided for Core, Intermediate, and Higher Anaesthesia ICM training, as well as ACCS and IMT. We could also support part of advanced training in partnership with a tertiary centre. There are Trust Grade jobs available in the department and we would be happy to work with Advanced Critical Care Practitioners.

We also have a Foundation 1 post and provide Foundation taster weeks.

Exposure to practical procedures such as percutaneous tracheostomy, vascular access, bronchoscopy; thoracic ultrasound, ECHO (including FICE mentorship), and regional anaesthesia.

#### 4.2 Details of departmental teaching

Formal ITU teaching is scheduled as part of a weekly Wednesday afternoon teaching programme. There is also an online Journal Club.

#### 4.3 Details of clinical governance meetings days and / or M & M

Governance and M&M takes place every 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday.
