



Person Specification for ICM Faculty Tutors

Essential Criteria	Desirable Criteria
Fellow or Associate Fellow of the Faculty of Intensive Care Medicine (FFICM/AFICM), on the specialist register and currently practicing Intensive Care Medicine.	Postgraduate educational qualification or training.
Experience in Educational Supervision of resident doctors in training. If limited, you must have mentorship from previous Faculty Tutor and/or Regional Advisor.	
Fellow in good standing (including ad eundem or Associate) of their partner College.	
Demonstrable ongoing interest in teaching and training.	Experience of managerial or organisational roles in education e.g. course director.
Support of consultant colleagues. If appointed less than 3 years ago you should have a mentor in post - usually previous Faculty Tutor and/or Regional Advisor.	
Recognised as a trainer by the General Medical Council.	
Support of employer confirmed by the Lead Clinician for ICM/Clinical Director. Clinical Director confirms role will be recognised in the applicants' job plan.	
Willingness to work with the local consultants, trust/health board and the Deanery's Schools.	
Familiarity with the FICM training curriculum and willingness to provide a comprehensive training programme.	Participated in Local or regional ICM teaching/training
Familiarity with the assessment system and willingness to participate in the ARCP process.	Attended ARCP in region
